## Heinzerling Community Employees Receive Scholarship Awards from OHCA

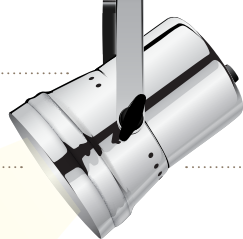

**Group Volunteers** – Open to corporate, social, & religious groups. These volunteers will attend prepared program activities at Heinzerling Community where they will “engage” with residents. In addition, group volunteers may help with landscaping projects, and assist us with our fundraising events each year.

**Volunteer Friend** – Open to all individuals age 14 and older. These individuals will provide companionship to residents. This may include assisting individuals with specific communication, social, motor, and or self-help skills.

**Volunteer Buddy** – Open to all 11,12,13-year old's with parent/guardian supervision. These individuals will provide friendship to residents by taking them for walks, read to them, and play simple games together.

**Music Therapy** – We are looking for community members to lead our residents in a variety of auditory experiences with musical instruments.

**Entertainment Volunteers** – We are looking for community artists to provide entertainment to our residents. Can include recital practices, music concerts, theater plays, magic shows, etc.

**Therapy Volunteers** – Limited to college students who are enrolled in occupational or physical therapy programs.

**Seamstress Volunteers** – We are in need of volunteers to sew name tags on resident clothing, add/remove to and from resident inventories, and to do clothing alterations. Also, make clothing protectors, lap quilts, binders, and other special needs projects.
